

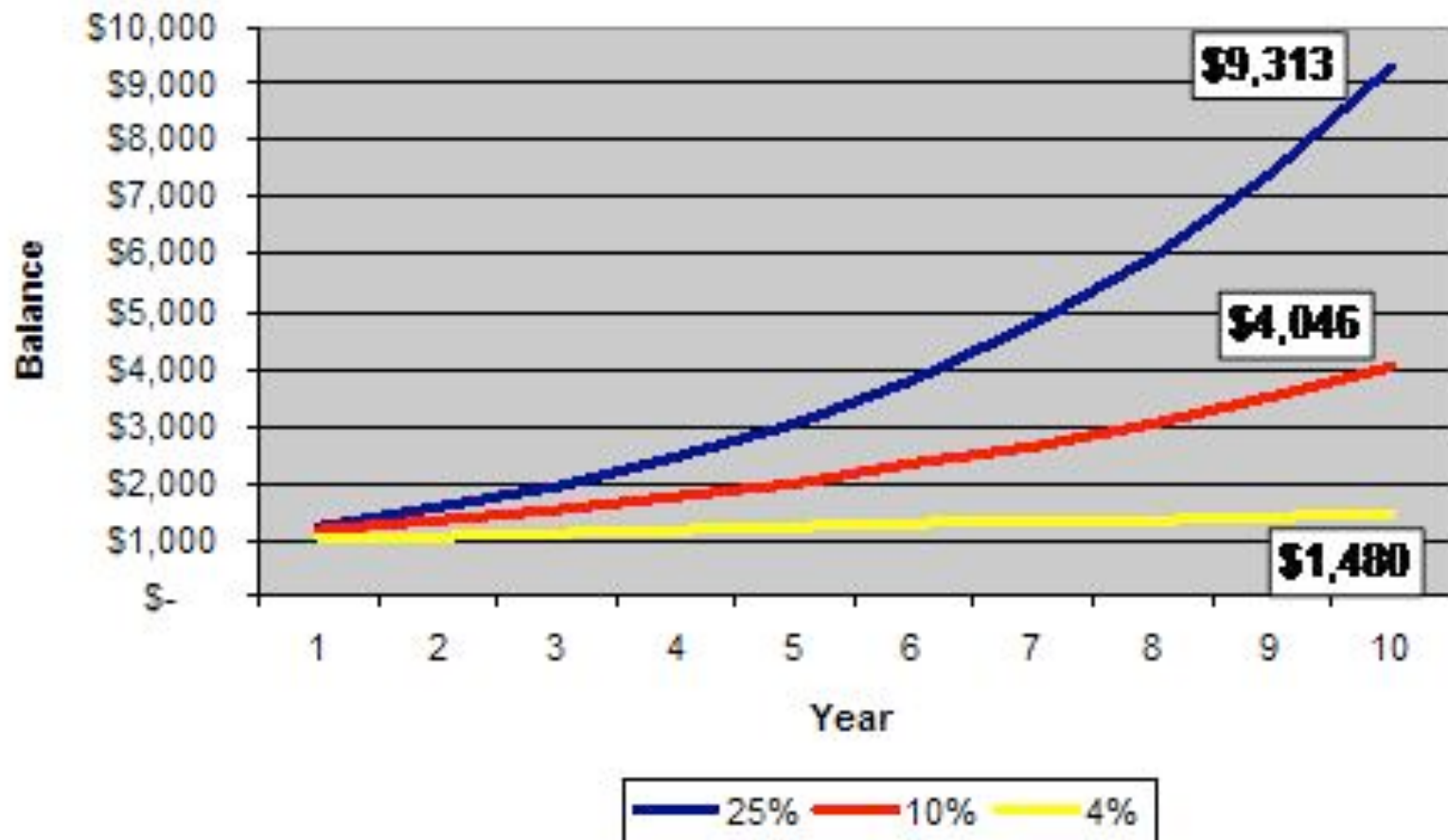

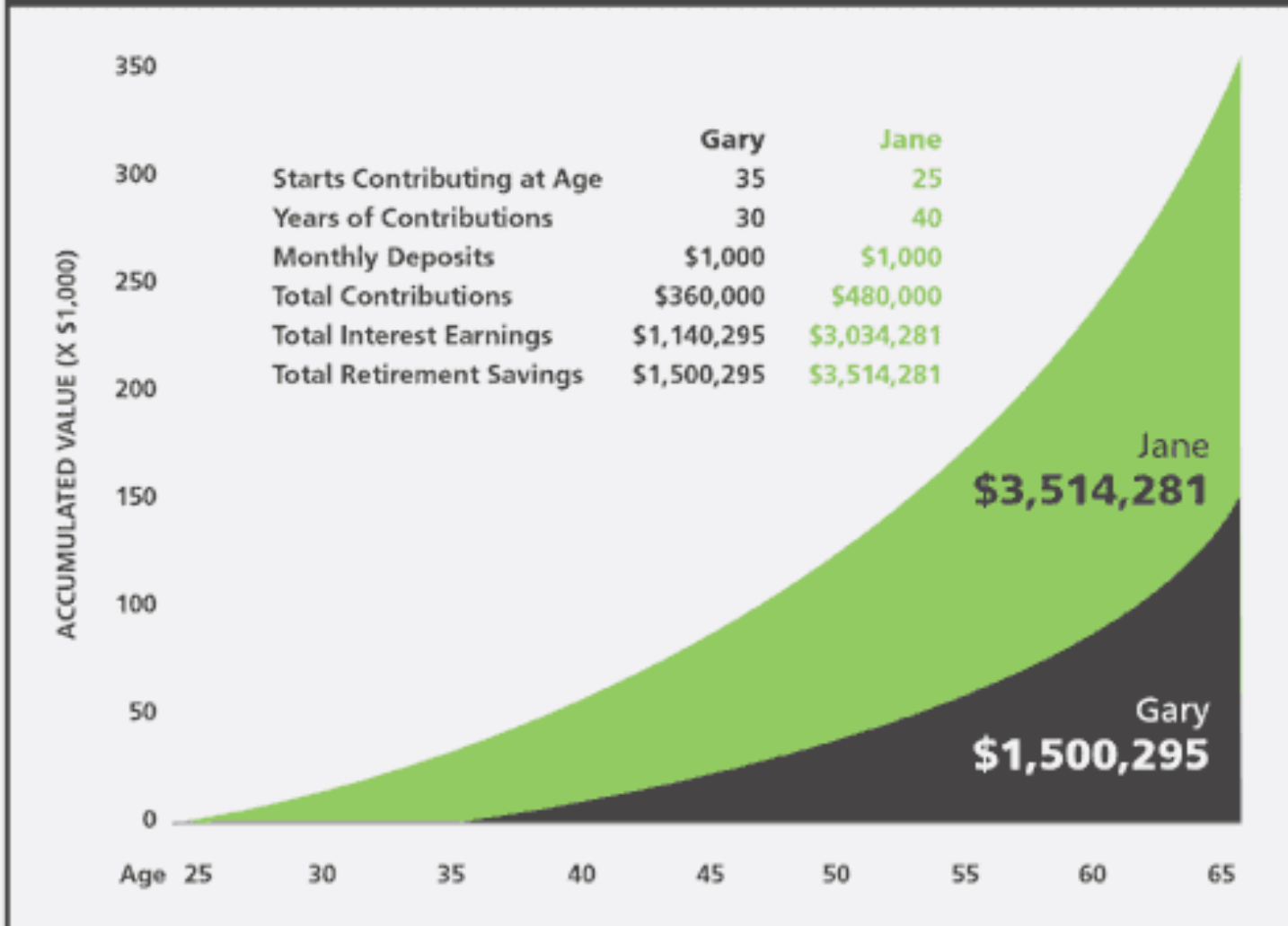

How the Power of Compounding Can Work for You

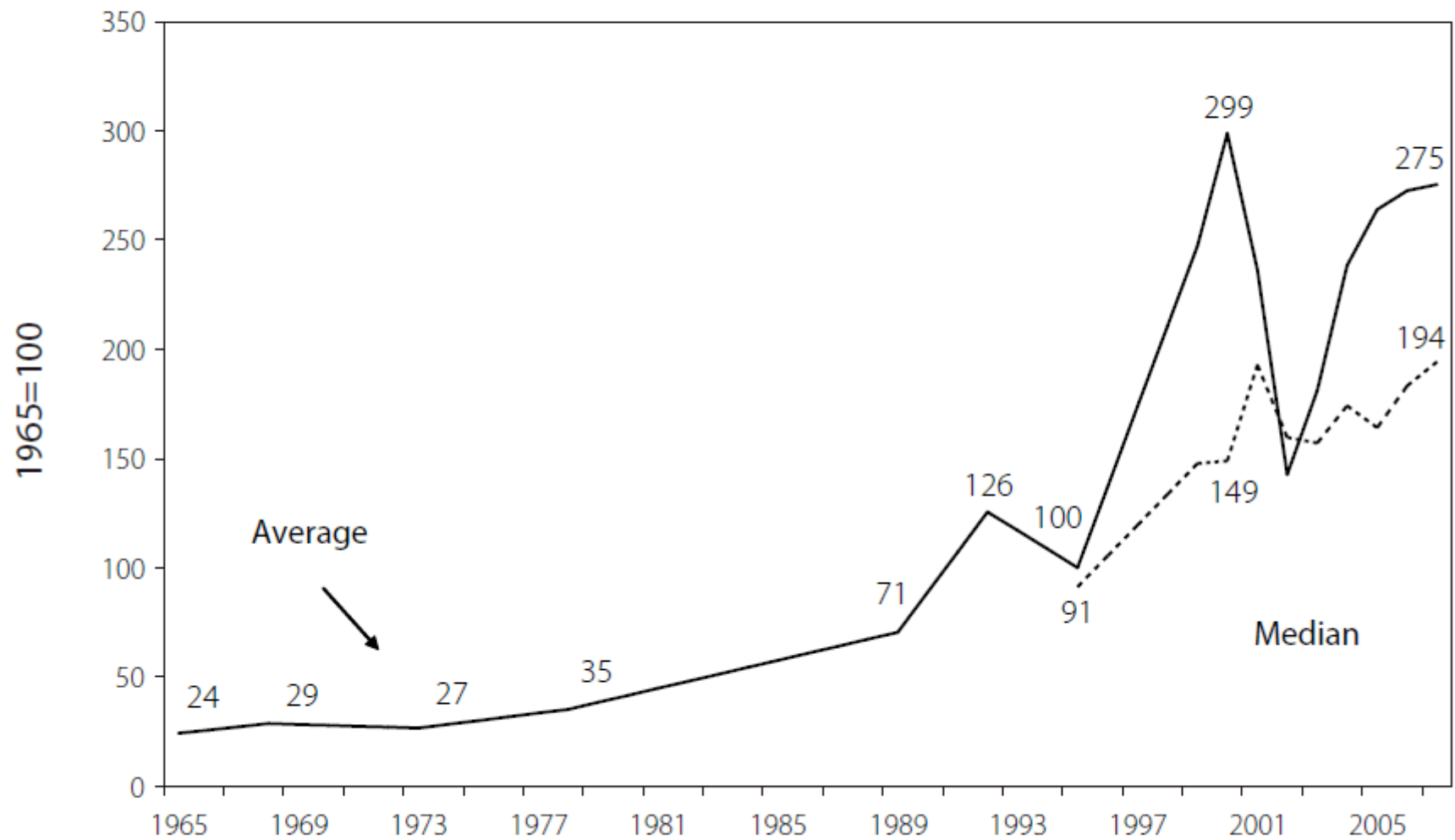
