



Welcome to **thyme**, your friendly medication tracking app.

When would someone use your app?

Someone would use the app whenever they were about to take their medication, when they wanted to log their symptoms regarding a medication, or when they wanted to check the progress of a friend or connected user.

What should a user be able to accomplish in this prototype?

Our user should be able to accomplish the following tasks:

- Tracking their daily medication use
- Logging their symptoms of a medication
- Generating a report of their medication usage
- Sharing the report with their connected users
- Adding a connected user

What tools did you use?

We used Figma to build our Med-Fi prototype, along with various other design tools to decide on our color palette. We used the Noun Project for our iconography and tested our prototype against colorblindness with Toptal to measure our apps accessibility.

What are the limitations?

We have filled out all of our tasks, but are still working to flesh out our value prop of the garden and the streak feature. In addition, users cannot yet customize their own medications or type their actual symptoms into the app (we are aiming for this for our final prototype). Due to the nature of Figma, a user's progress or task completion may not stay (i.e. if you fill out the check-in screen, the green mark may disappear after you go to another screen and return to that screen).

We have a few areas that are prepopulated and hard coded including: the user report, user connections, garden visualization, user symptoms, user medication plan.
