Although other apps might relate to our value proposition, Kith&Kin specifically caters to parents of younger children in finding social networks and support system while our competitor apps have either too broad of a reach or strictly targeted towards women





Problem & Solution

Problem	Solution
Parent Isolation & Loneliness	Meetup with other parents 1-on-1 with similar child age group, location proximity, language spoken, etc.
Limited Support Network	Share and celebrate each other's small parenting milestones within close network of friends (i.e. BeReal)
Difficulty Finding Resources & Parenting Questions	Ask for help & questions on community board to learn new remedies/ tips while bonding through shared struggles

Features:

- Creates an online platform for building communities with neighbors
- Lets you connect to people you already know by sharing contacts with other accounts, your phone, send automated invites, etc
- UI is very intuitive, similar to other social media apps like Facebook
- Handles moderation with nudges and ability to report posts


How we're unique:

- Focus on families specifically, not just all neighbors
- Have more specific resources/groups for things like searching for a professional pediatrician, rather than in general chat





Social.mom



- Users authenticated
- Customizable distance and child age
- Telemedicine services with answers from doctors 24/7
- Questions answers platform among parents
- Cute graphic & pink visuals targeting audience

Cons



- Telemedicine fee starting aat \$30/mo
 - Our app additionally has community event gathering posts
 - Unlike Social.mom, our age group isn't as broad and caters to parent of infants up to age 6
- Our app is inclusive of parents of all genders, unlike Social.mom



Wunder by Understood

Wunder is a free community app for parents of kids with learning and thinking differences, like ADHD and dyslexia

What works:

- Wide range of topics and expert-approved advice in content library and resources tab
- Ability to personalize app based on background and interests
- Ability to connect with experts in the app

What could be improved:

- Parent community can be intimidating and some are not very interactive ie there are several posts but few conversational threads
- Wunder places you in private groups based on your selected interests which limits your experience

What makes Kith&Kin unique and implications:

- Narrower target audience: parents of children aged 0 6 years.
- Ability to private message other users to foster one-on-one interactions
- Takeaway: include community moderators and expert-verified informational pages





Peanut-App.IO

What works:

- The app offers a variety of support groups for moms with different topics ranging from diets, nutritions, health, sports, to sleep.
- Diverse community with a lot of moms from different backgrounds.
- Lots of message boards with lots of definitive guides for moms on FAQs.


What doesn't work:

- Identity and safety checks are a concern, as many have reported that males catfishing as women to meet mothers on the app. No way to verify identity
- Meetups tend to be for moms who want to playdate for their kids. For mothers whose kids have special needs, it's really difficult.
- A lot of unrelated contents: sexy selfies, online sellers trying to find an audience, propaganda.

What we can take away:

- Identity and safety checks are really important and needs to be enforced
- Filters should help to match moms with similar interests, backgrounds to help with compatibility
- Work on interface and navigation to ensure moms are aware of what resources are available to them without being lost in the app.







Stakeholders

Direct

Parents: main users of the app who are meeting with strangers and interacting with questions and milestone celebrations

Indirect



Children: the experiences and advices shared on the app will influence the children's health and wellbeing

Educators/ childcare workers: they spend most time with children and their responsibility of giving childcare advices would be reduced with the app providing spaces for parents to ask questions and connect





Ethical Implications

The Scandal: Worry about safety; "Man met on community app kills mother of 3"

Our app would need to have security measures to screen users, create a sense of trust, and protect the privacy of users. We would also include guidelines for safety in our user norms, the option to report users, and community moderators.

The Siren: becoming an influencer platform, becoming toxic/parents comparing themselves

Our community guidelines could include a walkthrough on empathy and supporting peers. We would also have the option of only sharing posts within private groups where members are mutual friends.







Simple Leaves



Schedule a meetup with a parent (swipe left/right) + filtering community (languages)

Private messaging (connecting with schedule meetup)

Parents RSVP to a local event or one-on-one

Search for profile and add parents to your neighborhood

Moderate

On community board, ask a question on a message board

Creating specific smaller community group ("moms who cook")

Filter parents based on interests and backgrounds

Complex

Schedule and joining video calls

Share a recent parenting win with your friends ("villagers"), respond and interact with others

Blocking a harmful member / able to moderate / reporting contents


Able to set a max number of contacts you make (hid profile once they have met certain number of people, feature to set your interest in meeting up







