Value Tensions

- By strengthening deep connections we deemphasize making new ones
- A deadline to complete a playdate could make friendship feel like homework
- Pre-planned activities reduces the thoughtfulness one needs to put into planning events to make someone else feel special

- Hard to depict many different users



Limitations of Figma

- Interface with phone notifications
- Look of the app when opening it
- Functionality is harder than coding at times
- Timer Countdown
- Messages and interactions with users



Hard Coded and Wizard of OZ features

Hard Coded and Wizard of Oz

- Prepopulated playdates
- Hard-coded users, likes, invites, and comments
- Algorithm to create a recap video
- Ability to notify other people with a playdate
- Knowledge of location to filter playdates
- Filtering based on tags
