Part A: Add the tags and attributes to the *index.html* document as indicated in bold below.

<p>This is the budget summary for ABC, Inc. In the Year 2005, we had an income of
<span class="income">$74,935</span>. We had expenses of
<span class="expenses">$41,167</span>. This allowed us to have a profit of
<span class="profit">$33,768</span>.

<p>In 2000, we had an income of <span class="income">$50,123</span> and expenses of
<span class="expenses">$30,796</span>. This allowed us to have a profit of
<span class="profit">$19,327</span>.
</p>
<p>In 1995, we had an income of <span class="income">$35,182</span> and expenses of
<span class="expenses">$29,772</span>, for a total profit of
<span class="profit">$5,410</span>.
</p>
<p>In 1990, we had an income of <span class="income">$20,031</span> and expenses of
<span class="expenses">$19,271</span>, for a total profit of
<span class="profit">$760</span>.
</p>
<p>As you can see, we are constantly growing. As we move further into the 21st
century, at ABC, Inc. we think the future is bright!</p>
