Simple Frames Demo/Exercise

1. Open **Internet Explorer**
2. Under File, choose **Open...**
3. Click **Browse...**
4. Double-click **My Computer**, then double-click **3 1/2 Floppy (A:)**
5. Double-click **Frames**
6. Double-click **simpleframe**
7. Double-click **simpleframe.html**

While **Internet Explorer** is still up and running, open **Notepad**:

1. Click **Start**
2. Click **Run...**
3. Type **notepad** and press **Enter**
4. Click **File**
5. Click **Open**
6. Click on the pull-down menu and scroll to **3 1/2 Floppy (A:)**
7. Double-click **Frames**
8. Double-click **simpleframe**
9. Double-click **simpleframe.html**

Open up three more sessions of Notepad (click **Start** | type **Run** | type **notepad**) and open the files "f1.html", "f2.html", and "f3.html".

Make some changes to each of the frames (f1, f2, and f3).
Make some changes to the frameset file (simpleframe.html).
Play around with each to get an idea as to what each does.
View your changes in Internet Explorer.

Some suggestions:

- Change **simpleframe.html** to have different frameset information:
<frameset rows="30%,50,*"> or <frameset cols="40,15%,*">
 - Change f1.html, f2.html, and f3.html to reflect the changes in simpleframe.html (when you change it to 30%, 50, *, change f1.html to say "This frame is 30% high", etc.)

Complex Frames Demo/Exercise

1. Open **Internet Explorer**
2. Under **File**, choose **Open...**
3. Click **Browse...**
4. Double-click **My Computer**, then double-click **3 1/2 Floppy (A:)**

6. Double-click **complexframe**
7. Double-click **complex.html**

While **Internet Explorer** is still up and running, open **Notepad**:

1. Click **Start**

6. Click on the pull-down menu and scroll to **3 1/2 Floppy (A:)**
7. Double-click **Frames**
8. Double-click **complexframe**
9. Double-click **complex.html**

Open up six more sessions of Notepad (click **Start** | type **Run** | type **notepad**) and open the files "contact.html", "faq.html", "home.html", "new.html", "nf1.html", and "nf2.html".

Make some changes to each of the frames (contact, faq, home, new, nf1, nf2).

Make some changes to the frameset file (complex.html).

Play around with each to get an idea as to what each does.

View your changes in Internet Explorer.

Some suggestions:

- Change the attribute **target="rightframe"** to **target="_blank"** on the links in nf2.html
- Change the attribute **target="rightframe"** to **target="_self"** on the links in nf2.html
- Change the attribute **target="rightframe"** to **target="_top"** on the links in nf2.html
- Remove the attribute **target="rightframe"** completely.
