This update is being sent to all Stanford employees who are currently certified for DOT Shipping Dangerous Biological Goods or Dry Ice, (EHS-2700-WEB).

There are organizational changes to the ICAO/IATA packing instructions that all dangerous goods shippers must follow. The updates are:

- 1. The Packing Instruction number assigned to Infectious Substances, Category A has changed from 602 to 620.
- 2. The Packing Instruction for Dry Ice has changed from 904 to 954.

Note: The Packing Instruction number assigned to Biological Substances, Category B remains 650.
