

keynotes [med-fi prototype](#) README

Purpose:

keynotes is an app for music-makers to connect, give, and receive feedback.

Operating Instructions:

We used Figma to create this med-fi prototype due to its ability to simulate both the visual design and navigation aspects of phone screens. On top of these features, Figma has a reasonable learning curve and supports real-time collaboration.

There are certain clickable components on each screen, which can be used to navigate to other screens and are highlighted in blue when a non-clickable component is tapped. The navigation bar on the bottom takes the user to four different locations in the app: the user's profile (containing uploaded songs and feedback), an explore page to find new musicians, feed for the user's current friends, and a page to upload new tracks. From there, the user can find new musicians to connect with, upload new tracks to obtain feedback, and change and edit preferences for whom they want to receive feedback from.

Limitations

Though the user is able to navigate through the app and simulate the process of uploading videos/audio for feedback, the prototype does not test how users actually interact socially on the app. Furthermore, we have not implemented the messaging and "add a friend" features yet, so the prototype cannot test these interactions.

Hard-Coded and Wizard-of-Oz Items:

Currently, the upload audio/video is hard-coded; we have a default image (without audio, yet) and do not provide the option for the user to upload something of their own choice. Furthermore, the "algorithm" recommends only 2-3 predetermined other users. And finally, users cannot actually edit their profile or preferences yet, only see the hard-coded default settings.
