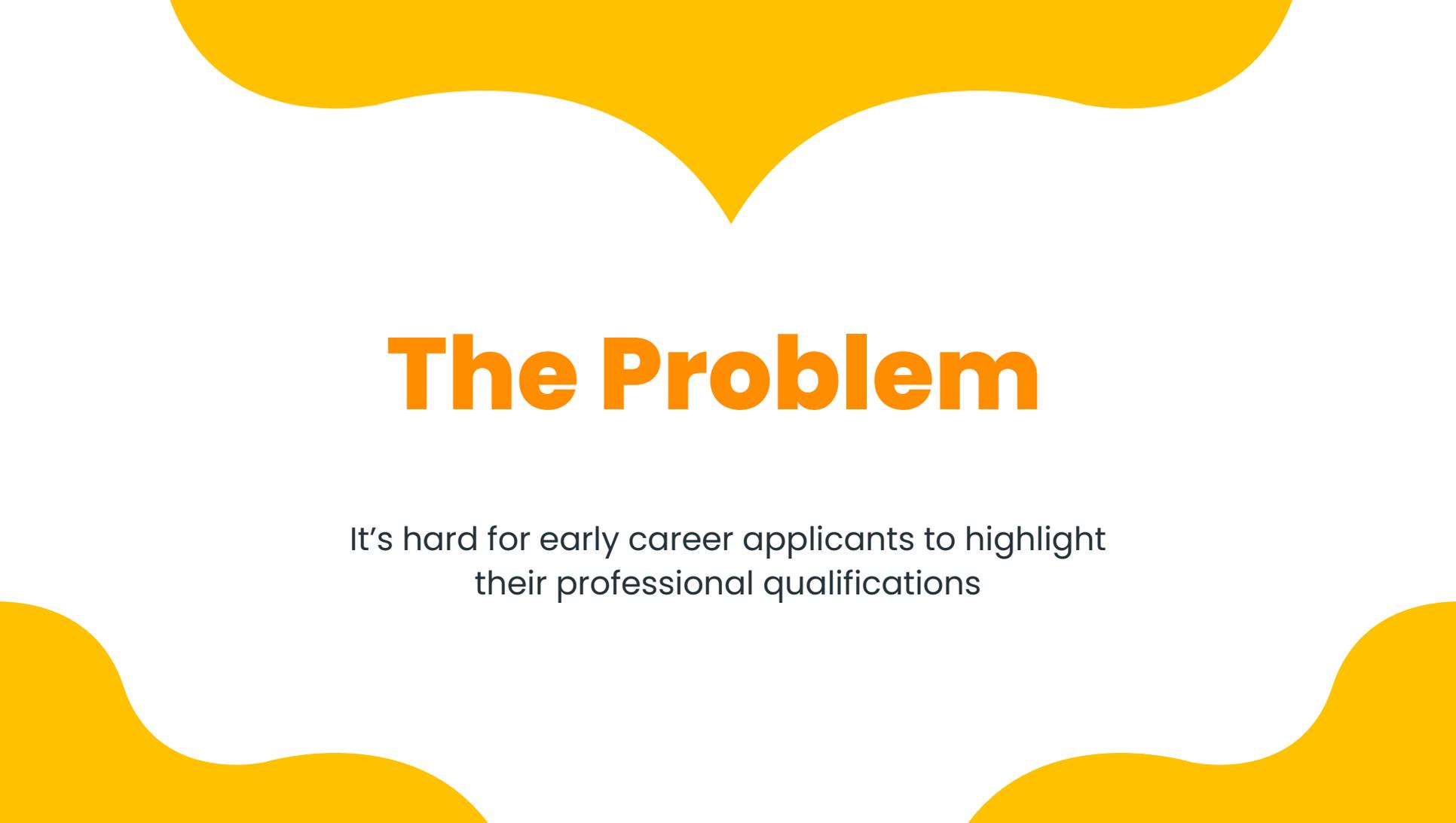

# The Problem

It's hard for early career applicants to highlight their professional qualifications

## The Solution: HireReel

**HireReel:** A platform for video endorsements from peers, former coworkers, or whoever, highlighting skills and capabilities of potential candidates.

“Let your skills shine through video endorsements”

# Values in Design

## Encoded Values

We wanted to encode **simplicity** and **professionalism** into the platform

## Design Choices

To accomplish this we used a **minimalist design** that **highlights essential features**.

## Tensions

It is **harder to guide** the user with a simpler design. There is **many stakeholders** to interact with for utility but this makes usage **less clear**.

# Usability Goals and Key Metrics



## Usability Goals

- Clarity between what is required for different stakeholders (User, Recruiter, and Endorser).
- Smooth transitions in between tasks.



## Key Metrics

- Time for task completion.
- Misclicks per task

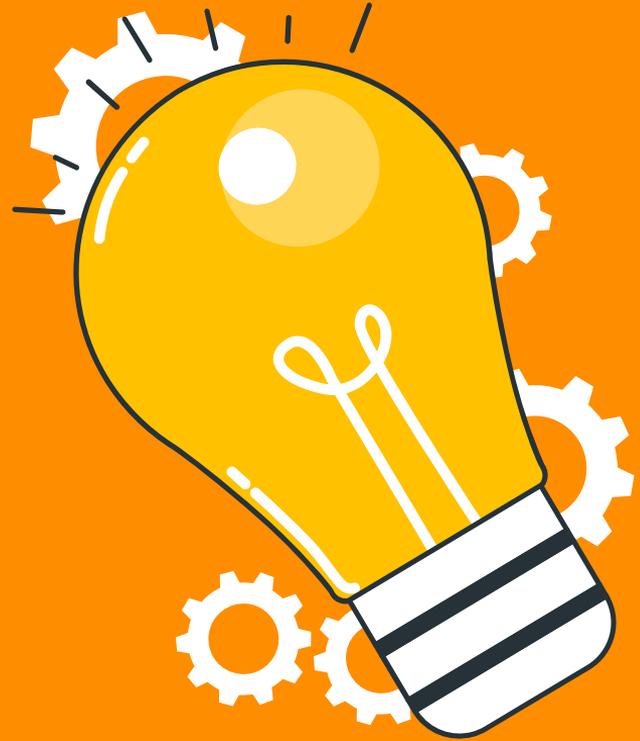
# Usability Goals and Key Metrics

## How are we achieving this?

- Focusing on the social aspects of the application and simplifying ancillary tasks.
- Going from user, recruiter, and endorser as stakeholders to user/endorser and recruiter to reduce complexity
- Modifying task flows to reduce the number of click it takes to complete tasks.

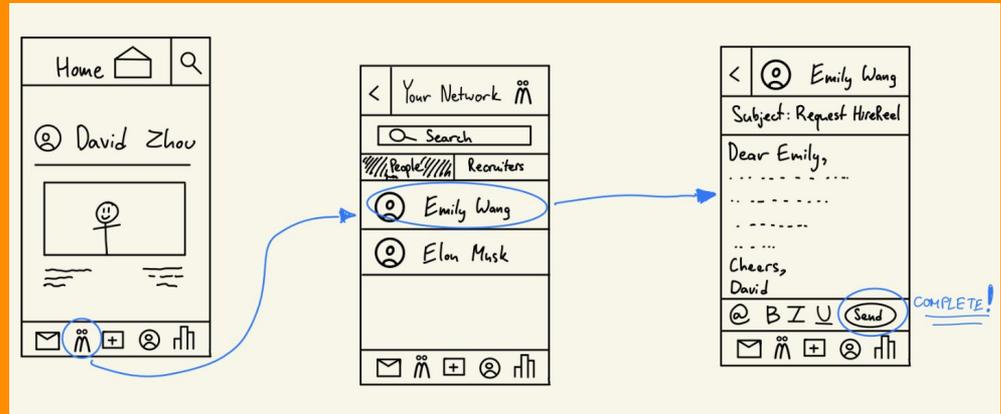
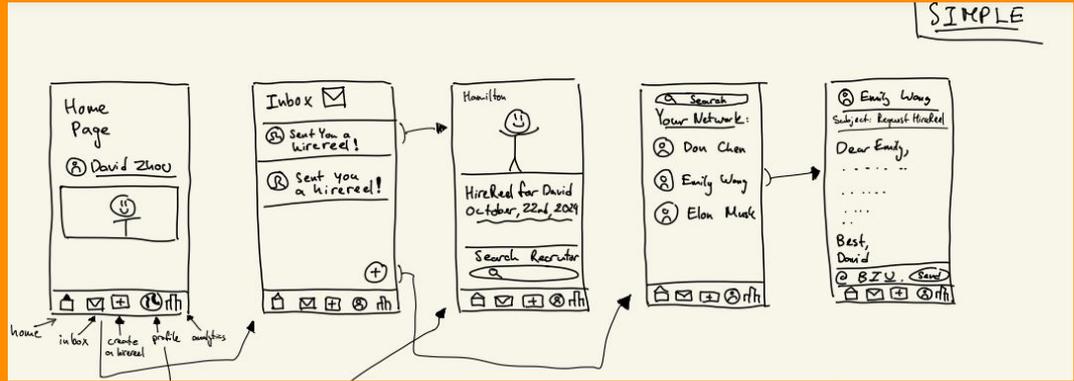


# Simple Task: Request an Endorsement

The simple task took users the longest to complete.

We reduced the number of screens.

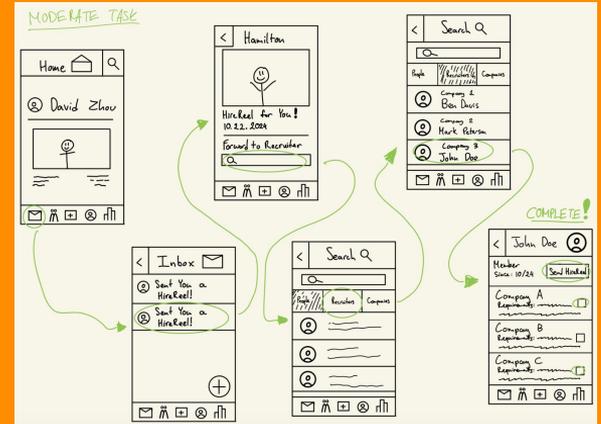
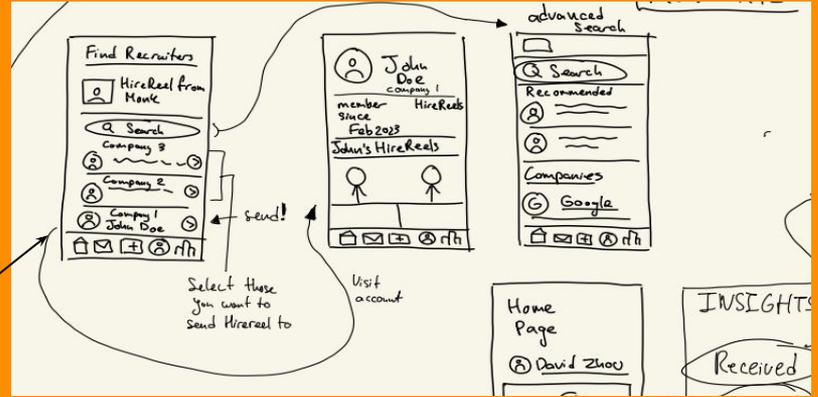
On the prototype the home and send screens have been further streamlined.



# Moderate Task: Send HireReel to Recruiter

The moderate task was the most unintuitive out of all the tasks we tested.

We made a more robust and clear task flow that enables users to more easily intuit how to send a HireReel they've received to a potential recruiter!

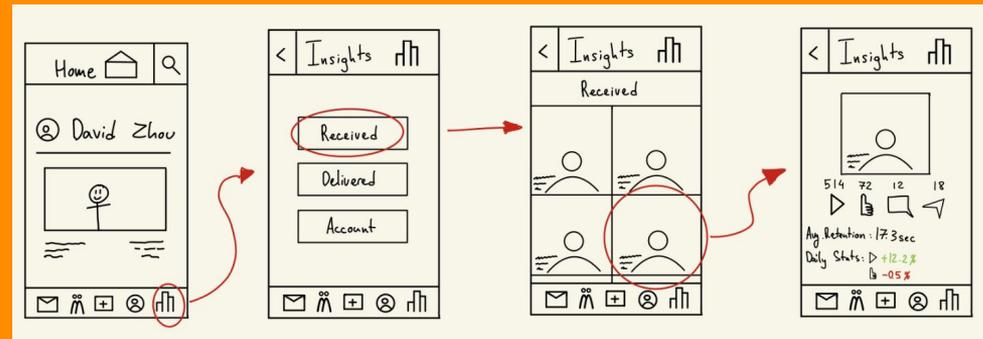
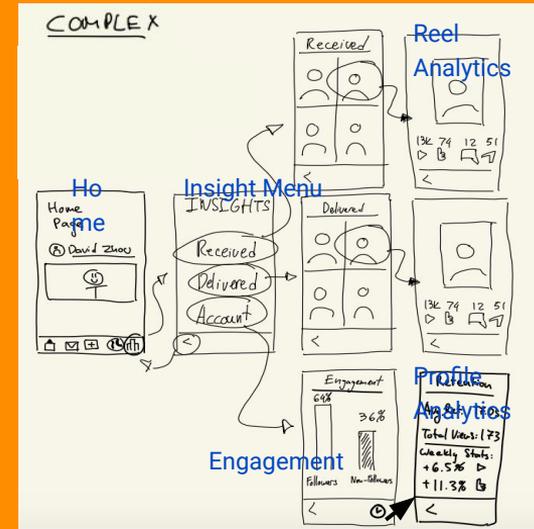


# Complex Task: View Analytics

This task was the most straightforward, so we've made very few changes to in our med-fi prototype.

Some icons were changed to make the actions more clear.



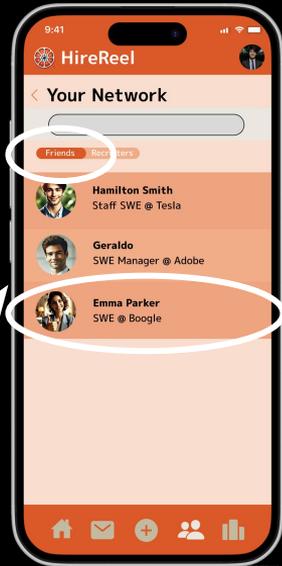

# Medium-fi Simple Task Flow



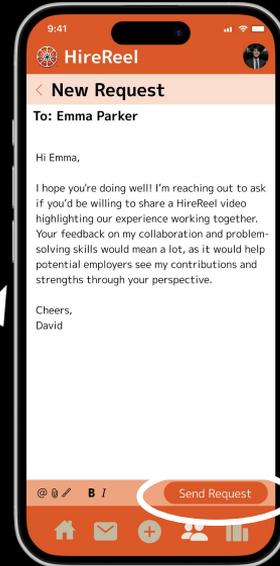
Users can navigate to their connections from the navigation bar



After selecting a connection, users can find people in their personal network



After selecting a connection, you can request a HireReel from them



Users will be able to write a message requesting a HireReel



A final notification will prompt the user that a request has been sent!

Users can navigate to their connections from the **navigation bar**

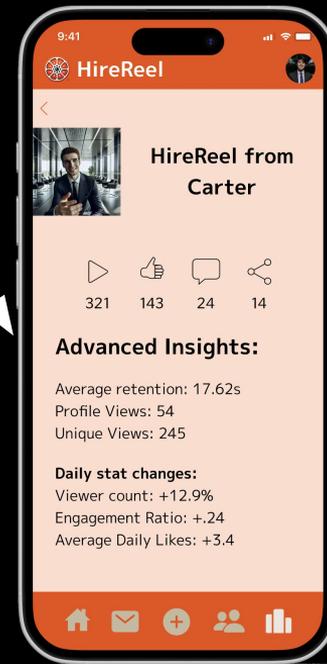
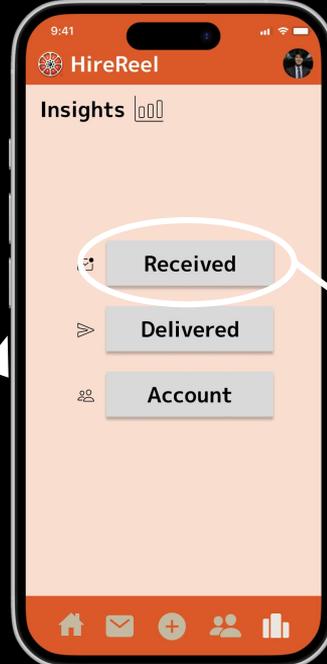
Pressing this button after selecting a recruiter will send the HireReel to them.

Users can navigate to insights from the **navigation bar**



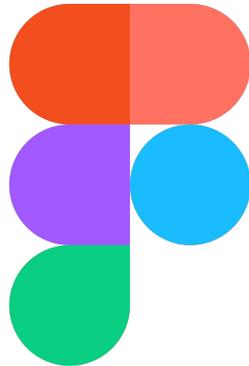
Analytics help candidates gauge the engagement of the HireReels they send to recruiters, allowing them to better understand their strengths and weaknesses.

## Design Tools

**Figma** was mainly used to create the medium-fidelity prototype as it enables users to cohesively craft a user interface that can be displayed and interacted with in the form of a mobile app. Other tools we used included **DALL-E** for generating images to put into our prototype, and **Microsoft OneNote** for creating sketches.



# Limitations

- Because we don't have a real network, making an account and the option to import connections at the beginning is artificial.
- Because we only wanted to demonstrate the necessary screens for completing the tasks we thought important, we only made certain messages and HireReels clickable to avoid redundancies.
- Our Figma prototype does not have the ability for further UI customization which limits accessibility options.
- Our HireReel videos are only displayed as thumbnails, and do not allow for seeing how a HireReel looks like as a video.
- There is no way we could realistically create a search algorithm in the event the user wants to search for recruiters. There is also no database for recruiters to exist in.

## Hard Coded Items

- An account and network is already established for the user. Connections such as recruiters of interest, former employers, and friends are already included in the prototype.
- The included account already has several HireReels from connections.

## Wizard of Oz Techniques

- The loading screen animation is a set length.
- Because there is no real network that the prototype operates on, messages sent and received serve to demonstrate the process of those apps, and what the user interface appears to be after performing those tasks.
- The insights on the HireReels are all artificially generated numbers representative of a typical HireReel.
